## THE SOLEMNITY OF SAINT TIMOTHY

### **Introit** *Statuit ei (Sir 45:24; Ps 132:1)*

The Lord hath established a covenant of peace with him, And made him a chief of his people: that he should have the priestly dignity for ever and ever. (Ps) Lord, remember David: and all his trouble. **GLORY.** The Lord...

### **Collect**

Heavenly Father, who didst send thine Apostle Paul to preach the Gospel, and gavest him Timothy and Titus to be his companions in the Faith: grant that, through their prayers, our fellowship in the Holy Spirit may bear witness to the Name of Jesus; who liveth and reigneth with thee, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, ever one God, world without end. Amen.

### **First Reading** *2 Timothy 1:1-8*

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God according to the promise of life which is in Christ Jesus, To Timothy, my beloved child: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. I thank God whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.

As I remember your tears, I long night and day to see you, that I may be filled with joy. I am reminded of your sincere faith, A faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you. For this reason I remind you to rekindle the gift of God that is within you through the laying on of my hands; for you did not give us a spirit of timidity but a spirit of power and love and self-control. Do not be ashamed then of testifying to our Lord, nor of me his prisoner, but take your share of suffering for the Gospel in the power of God.

### **Gradual** *Ecce sacerdos magnus (Sir 44:16,20)*

Behold, a mighty prelate: who in his lifetime was pleasing unto God.

V. There was none found like unto him: that observed the law of the Most High.

### **Second Reading** *2 Timothy 1:13-14; 2:1-3*

Beloved: Follow the pattern of the sound words which you have heard from me, in the faith and love which are in Christ Jesus; guard the truth that has been entrusted to you by the Holy Spirit who dwells in us. You then, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus; and what you have heard from me before many witnesses entrust to the faithful men who will be able to teach others also. Take your share of suffering as a good soldier of Christ Jesus.

### **Alleluia** *Laudate Deum (Ps 148:2)*

Alleluia. Alleluia. Thou art a priest for ever: after the order of Melchisedech. Alleluia.

### **Gospel** *Luke 10:1-9*

At that time: The Lord appointed seventy others, and sent them on ahead of him, two by two, into every town and place where he himself was about to come. And he said to them, "the harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; pray therefore the Lord of the harvest to

send out laborers into his harvest. Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs in the midst of wolves. Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals; and salute no one on the road. Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace be to this house!' And if a son of peace is there, your peace shall rest upon him; but if not, it shall return to you. And remain in the same house, eating and drinking what they provide, for the laborer deserves his wages; do not go from house to house. Whenever you enter a town and they receive you, Eat what is set before you; Heal the sick in it and say to them, "The Kingdom of God has come near to you"
